Sub: Centrally Sponsored Scheme relating to development of infrastructure facilities for the judiciary – Release of financial assistance to the **Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir** during the year 2019-2020.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of **Rs. 5,00,00,000/- (Rupees Five Crore only)** during 2019-2020 to the **Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir** under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for development of infrastructure facilities for judiciary for construction of court buildings and residential accommodation for judges/judicial officers covering District and Subordinate Courts. The High Courts are not covered under the revised scheme.

2. The expenditure involved is debit to Demand No. 63 during 2019-20 under Major Head 3602 – Grants-in-aid to Union Territory Governments with Legislature, Sub Major Head 06 – Centrally Sponsored Schemes, Minor Head 06.101 – Central Assistance/Share, Sub Head 45 – Infrastructural facilities for Judiciary, Object Head 45.00.35 – Grants for Creation of Capital Assets.

3. The Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmiris requested to utilize this amount during the current financial year 2019-20. No fund sharing pattern is applicable for Union Territory. **Funds are released for ongoing and new Projects complying with the norms and specification for the construction of court halls and residential quarters of subordinate judiciary, as per the extant Guidelines of the Scheme. The Union Territory Administration may furnish the Project-wise details for the projects against which above funds are allocated/Utilised.** The details of amount spent by the Union Territory Administration along-with audit certificate, utilization certificate in the prescribed format (GFR-19A) duly signed by the competent authority and physical achievements may please be sent to this Department at the earliest.

4. The accounts of the Union Territory Administration in respect of the Grants being released shall be open to inspection by the Sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Account Office of the Department of Justice, whenever the State Government is called upon to do so.


