Subject: **Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for the Development of Infrastructural Facilities for the Judiciary – Release of Central Share to the Union Territory of Puducherry during 2015 - 2016.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of **Rs. 2,59,68,326/- (Rupees Two Crore Fifty Nine Lakh Sixty Eight Thousand Three Hundred & Twenty Six only)** during the year 2015-16 as Central share to the Union Territory of Puducherry under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for development of Infrastructure facilities for judiciary, for construction of court buildings and residential accommodation for judges / judicial officers covering District and Subordinate Courts. The High Courts are not covered under the revised Scheme.

2. The expenditure involved is debitable to Demand No. 64 during 2015-16 under Major Head 3602 – Grants-in-aid to UT Governments (with legislature), 04 Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Scheme (Sub Major Head), 04.891 – Administration of Justice Other Grants (Minor Head), 01- Grant for Infrastructural facilities for Judiciary, 01.00.35 – Grants for creation for Capital Assets.
3. The Union Territory of Puducherry is requested to utilise this amount during the current financial year 2015-2016. The details of the amount spent by the UT Administration, alongwith audit certificate, utilisation certificate in the prescribed format (GFR-19A) duly signed by the competent authority and physical achievements may please be sent to this Department at the earliest & latest by the end of the stipulated period in this regard.
4. The accounts of the UT Administration in respect of the Grant being released shall be open to inspection by the Sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Account Office of the Department of Justice, whenever the State Government is called upon to do so.
5. This sanction has been entered in the Register of Grants at Serial No. 16 at page No. 15-16.
