I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for the payment of Rs.5,00,00,000/-(Rupees Five Crore Only) during 2020-21 as central assistance to the Government of Meghalaya under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for development of Infrastructure facilities for judiciary, for construction of court buildings and residential accommodation for judges /judicial officers covering District and Subordinate Courts. The High Courts are not covered under the revised Scheme.

- 2. The expenditure involved is debitable to Demand No. 64 during 2020-21 under Major Head 3601 Grants–in-aid to State Governments, Sub Major Head 06 Centrally Sponsored Schemes, Minor Head 06.101 Central Assistance/Share, Sub Head 57 Infrastructural facilities for Judiciary, Detailed Head 03 –Infrastructural facilities for Judiciary, Object Head 57.03.35 Grants for Creation of Capital Assets.
- 3. The State Government is requested to utilize this amount along-with the State Government's Share on the pattern of 60:40 for States other than North Eastern and Himalayan States and 90:10 for States in North Eastern and Himalayan Region sharing basis between Central and State Governments. Funds are released for ongoing and new Projects complying with the norms and specification for the construction of court halls and residential quarters of subordinate judiciary, as per the extant Guidelines of the Scheme. The State Government may furnish the Project-wise details for the projects against which above funds are allocated / Utilised. The details of amount spent by the State Government along-with audit certificate, utilization certificate in the prescribed format (GFR-19A) duly signed by the competent authority and physical achievements may please be sent to this Department at the earliest.
- 4. The accounts of the State Government in respect of the Grants being released shall be open to inspection by the Sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Account Office of the Department of Justice, whenever the State Government is called upon to do so.
- 5. This sanction has been entered in the Register of Grants at Serial No. 7at page no. 25-26.
- 6. This issues with the concurrence of IFD (Law) *vide* Note no 101 dated 26.05.2020 (efile no 498) and approval of Secretary (Justice) *vide* Note no 102 dated 26.05.2020.
