Subject: Centrally Sponsored Scheme relating to development of infrastructural facilities for the judiciary – Release of Central Assistance to the **Union Territory of Puducherry** for the year 2016-2017.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for the payment of **Rs. 25,00,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Crore Only)** during 2016-17 as central assistance to the **Union Territory of Puducherry** under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for development of Infrastructure facilities for judiciary, for construction of court buildings and residential accommodation for judges /judicial officers covering District and Subordinate Courts. The High Courts are not covered under the revised Scheme.

2. The expenditure involved is debit to Demand No. 56 during 2016-17 under Major Head 3602 – Grant-in-Aid to the UT Governments (with Legislature) 04 – Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Scheme (Sub Major Head) 04.891 - Administration of Justice – Other Grants (Minor Head), 01 - Grants for infrastructural facilities for Judiciary, 01.00.35 Grants for Creation of Capital Assets.

3. The Union Territory of Puducherry is requested to utilize this amount during the current financial year 2016-17. The details of the amount spent by the UT Administration, along-with audit certificate, utilization certificate in the prescribed format (GFR-19A) duly signed by the competent authority and physical achievements may please be sent to this Department at the earliest & latest by the end of the stipulated period in this regard.

4. The accounts of the UT Administration in respect of the Grants being released shall be open to inspection by the Sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Account Office of the Department of Justice, whenever the State Government is called upon to do so.

5. This sanction has been entered in the Register of Grants at Serial No. 8 at page no. 17-18.
