Subject: **Centrally Sponsored Scheme for development of infrastructure facilities for the judiciary – Release of Central Assistance to the Government of Karnataka for the year 2017-2018.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for the payment of **Rs. 50,00,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Crore Only)** during 2017-18 as central assistance to the Government of Karnataka under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for development of Infrastructure facilities for judiciary, for construction of court buildings and residential accommodation for judges /judicial officers covering District and Subordinate Courts. The High Courts are not covered under the revised Scheme.

2. The expenditure involved is debitable to Demand No. 61 during 2017-18 under Major Head 3601 – Grants-in-aid to State Governments, Sub Major Head 06 – Centrally Sponsored Schemes, Minor Head 06.101 – Central Assistance/Share Grants for Infrastructural for Judiciary, Sub Head 57 – Grants for Infrastructural facilities for judiciary, Detailed Head 03 – Grants for Infrastructural facilities for judiciary, Object Head 57.03.35 – Grants for Creation of Capital Assets.

3. The State Government is requested to utilize this amount along-with the State Government's Share on the pattern of 60:40 sharing basis between Central and State Governments. Priority should be given to completing the on-going projects. The details of amount spent by the State Government along-with audit certificate, utilization certificate in the prescribed format (GFR-19A) duly signed by the competent authority and physical achievements may please be sent to this Department at the earliest latest by the end of the stipulated period in this regard.

4. The accounts of the State Government in respect of the Grants being released shall be open to inspection by the Sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Account Office of the Department of Justice, whenever the State Government is called upon to do so.

5. This sanction has been entered in the Register of Grants at Serial No. 9 at page no. 3-4.
